BEDWAS, TRETOMAS AND MACHEN (BTM) BAND

The BTM Band is one of the most famous names in Welsh banding, representing Wales at the European Championships and at the National Brass Band Championships of Great Britain. More recently, the band qualified for the semi finals of Band Cymru 2018.
